Creating a Fair, Consistent System

The International Chief Judge Advisory Group is working to standardize concours d'elegance judging

Objective class judging focused on originality and authenticity promotes proper preservation and correct restoration for the benefit of future generations

When the term “concours d’elegance” is used to describe a car show, many people think it is a contest of elegance for all awards.

This was true in the early days of the concours in France, when all entrant cars were new, but it is not the case today.

While there are shows with a total judging focus on such things as elegance, presentation or significance, many other judging methods are used. The manner of judging can vary considerably from one show to another — there is no consistency.

Use of the words “concours d’elegance” for car shows is really directed to how a Best of Show winner is selected. Here there is consistency.

Almost all shows use elegance as a factor in selecting Best of Show from the class winners. Many shows also have other major and special awards that are often based on elegance, presence or significance. Normally, judged cars and display cars are eligible for such awards. That leaves class judging and the selection of the class winners.

Different methods of class judging

Class judging can range all the way from the class entrants subjectively choosing the class winners to an experienced and knowledgeable three-person judging team objectively judging for originality and authenticity. There are all shades in between, including such things as the class judges submitting a list of award candidates to the organizer, who then selects the class winner.

In other cases, the organizer reserves the right to change the class results. There is not much to be said for fairness and consistency in the use of many such methods.

In discussing concours judging, we are primarily talking about the many non-club shows taking place in the U.S. and other countries. The major marque clubs have their own concours events, which are usually quite serious and based on originality and authenticity.

Some marque clubs are so serious that the judging process almost topples under its own weight. Such methods lead to nitpicking and failure to recognize that cars are

meant to be driven. It leads to owners being afraid to use their cars for fear of a minor deduction. This is contrary to just about everything a true car enthusiast should hold dear.

There is a balance to be achieved in good judging, and the Classic Car Club of America and the Ferrari Club of America are good examples in this regard.

Subjective vs. objective judging

Why is class judging so important? Many say a trophy is a trophy — meaningful or not. That completely ignores the responsibility we all have as temporary custodians of automotive history.

Objective class judging focused on originality and authenticity promotes proper preservation and correct restoration for the benefit of future generations.

Subjective class judging can and sometimes does award cars that are not correct in terms of originality and authenticity. Unless very good records are kept, which is often not the case, such awards can distort the true provenance of the car.

All shows are independent and free to do whatever kind of judging they wish. However, more shows need to recognize the importance of serious judging and meaningful awards.

Fairness and consistency

The International Chief Judge Advisory Group was formed in 2015 to promote more fairness and consistency in concours judging, while emphasizing originality and authenticity and recognizing cars are meant to be driven.

I founded the group, which includes 15

of the best chief judges in the car world. These judges come from six countries. Further, a group of 30 experienced senior chief class judges — who support serious class judging and use of the ICJAG judging forms and judging guidelines — are involved.

The purpose of ICJAG is to provide voluntary assistance to concours organizers and chief judges interested in improving their judging. ICJAG is currently working with more than 30 shows in 12 countries.

The ICJAG judging process is derived from judging forms and judging guidelines developed for the Ferrari Club of America in the 1980s and supported by the International Advisory Council for Preservation of the Ferrari Automobile.

The Palm Beach Cavallino Classic and all classes at the Pebble Beach Concours d'Elegance adopted the ICJAG forms and guidelines in the 1990s. While the process provides for fair and consistent judging, it is important to have a strong chief judge and several experienced senior chief class judges to help lead the effort.

Many concours, particularly local shows, do not have the desired depth of judging knowledge and experience.

However, ICJAG judging forms and guidelines still provide a fair and consistent judging process — where all entrants are treated the same.

As experience and knowledge is gained, the judging at such shows will only get better. In addition to field judging, ICJAG holds training seminars in several countries and has a mentoring program for young judges. (*Visit www.icjag.org for more information.*) ■
